



Dear South Island Plantation Residents,

Kyle, FirstService Residential Landscape Advisor, visited South Island Plantation on Wednesday, January 20, 2021 and these are the items he suggested the Moore Brother's address:

- The pinestraw around the clubhouse needs to be tucked on hard edges. The pinestraw is blowing away in a lot of areas because it was blow tucked.
- There is debris in the beds that needs to be removed. Some is from wind, but some is from pruning.
- There is new palm growth in the beds. They need to be weed-eated and sprayed.
- Is the palm pruning completed? There were a handful of palms throughout that had dead fronds.
- There are trees on the backside of the clubhouse that are touching/rubbing the clubhouse. Mostly it is the crepe myrtles.
- There are still weeds in beds throughout the community that needs to be sprayed. They may need to apply snapshot to assist in the larger beds.
- The shrubs need to be cut back off the dumpster enclosure to prevent damages.
- This is not for the Moore's, is there a pond maintenance plan. There are a lot of weeds growing in the ponds already. Too many weeds in the summer equals pond health issues and provides dangers to the fish in the ponds.
- When they are mowing and weed eating around the ponds, all the trimmings are being discharged into the ponds.
- There are a couple broken signs in the community.
- It looks like a dog or some sort of animal has dug holes along Plantation Blvd that need to be cleaned up.
- Dollarweed in the juniper at the entrance.
- Mulch at the guard house needed.
- Continue edging all paths. We still haven't reclaimed edges along the asphalt community paths.
- Ruts in the turf by the pool and past ruts by the clubhouse.
