Besides the dryness of the turf, South Island has come a long way. It is night and day compared to last year at this time and the Moore Brothers are doing a great job considering the circumstances. With that being said, here is a list of items that I saw when I was on site walking:

- Where do we stand on the pond maintenance? Have we considered at a minimum basic maintenance or fish stocking?
 - The Moore Brother's were working with a vendor to get us a quote on this, I will follow up with it on
- Tree clearance on the sidewalks. Some trees are over hanging and may hit someone walking on the sidewalks.



• Along the sidewalk on the inbound side, there was a tree that has a lot of broken limbs hanging. This is along the pond area adjacent to the pool.



• The islands have new palms trying to grow throw the turf and beds. They need to be cut and sprayed.



• Sucker growth on the crepe myrtles.



• Weeds in the yaupon holly beds and weeds in the jasmine beds. Maybe need to use Acclaim or Lontrell to control.





- Some broken palm fronds need to be removed at the entrance
- Dollarweed in the juniper at the entrance.



• Dead tree on the exit side headed towards the entrance



• Dead palm leaning into a tree on Belle Rive road and Commanders Island Road.



• Crackweeds on sidewalk and pool area.



- Repair the ruts on side walking path. Need to bring in a sand mix and tamp it.
- Weeds in Shrubs at the clubhouse.
- Prune the azaleas or dead head the flowers.
- Weed eat around the trees that are not in beds.
- We should be back on regular mowing. If you are unable to mow specific lots, please mow and edge the verge between the sidewalk and the road for appearance.
- There was some buildup along the curbing in the community. If not blown away, it will end up in the pond which has long term affects.
- The path on the back left next to lot 50 needs to be edged. The edge needs to be reclaimed.

- Potential new sinkhole forming at Rosebank next to the stormwater access. Need to monitor.
- No pinestraw in beds at Millbrook in the island area.
- Lightning strike on a tree on Daisy Bank. Close to the road and is a fall hazard.
- There is an American Flag that was drilled into a palm tree on lot 187. Does anyone know anything about this?



Docks:

I took a walk out on the dock while I was on site and noticed a few things.

- The fire hydrants are not in the holders
- Some of the side panels and foot boards are warped or rotted
- There is some landscaping that needs repaired
- The swings are broken at the bottom (I thought I had a picture but I do not)
- Toni called tot state the items put out to block the boat launch are no longer than and the owner that lives on site are afraid someone or her dogs will fall in.
