

SIP POND MAINTENANCE REPORT

Report from The Greenery:

"We have been both treating the ponds and using a dye to help shade the sunlight from getting to the bottom of the ponds. This will help to limit the regrowth of submerged vegetation. As we head into the cooler months we will stop using the dye and begin again starting late Feb early March. The treatments have yielded good results with much of the plant material being controlled. However, there is still some of the leftover plant material that needs to continue to break down. In ponds 3 and 6 we needed to cut back some of the overgrown vegetation along the bank to gain access with our boat. These ponds were initially receiving partial treatments. The ponds had nearly 100% coverage of weeds, and partial treatments help to minimize having dissolved oxygen issues post application. We will continue to be onsite twice this month, then once during Jan and Feb. Clark, my field manager was onsite yesterday, and noted that the ponds are looking pretty good overall. Please let me know if there is anything else I can do."
